Located in the heart of leafy Bloomsbury and overlooking Brunswick Square, the Foundling Museum can be exclusively yours for a memorable event. From lively drinks receptions and elegant dinner parties, to focused meetings and away days, the Museum blends historic grandeur with contemporary design.

We present the story of the Foundling Hospital, the UK's first children's charity and public art gallery. Founded in 1739 by the campaigner Thomas Coram, it was an innovative home for children whose mothers couldn't care for them, supported by leading artists including William Hogarth, George Frideric Handel and Charles Dickens. Their compassion and generosity show that art transforms lives. Inspired by our 300-year history of social change, today we work with outstanding contemporary artists, writers and musicians to deliver ambitious projects for young people and marginalised groups.

Situated within a Grade II-listed, Georgianstyle building, the Museum houses a wealth of treasures, including Handel's will and paintings by William Hogarth, alongside works of art by leading contemporary artists.

As a registered charity, all income from venue hire supports our work with marginalised and vulnerable children.



Tube

The nearest tube station is Russell Square which is a four minute walk from the Museum.

Rail


The nearest train stations are King's Cross St Pancras and Euston.
